- Excel
 - Exportable reports
- Word
 - Mail merge

Salesforce.com

- Outlook Contacts, Email, Calendar Activities, Tasks
- Excel Export reports
- Word Mail merge



What are other CRM providers doing?

blackbaud[®]

Raiser's Edge

- Outlook Contacts, Email, Calendar Activities, Tasks
- Excel Export reports, Uses F9 for financial reporting
- Word Mail merge

Note: Very complicated integration over 300 pages of instructions of how to install and use the office integration. Many COM Add-in and other data objects must be installed and configured correctly.



Common Problems



- Outlook must be open and running in order to sync (does not sync to the exchange server)
- Bi-direction syncing between Outlook to CRM and CRM to Outlook is problematic
- Connection/integration unreliable
- Cannot sync shared calendars
- Will only sync limited contacts (5,000 for Salesforce)
- Commonly used Outlook functionality does not sync (Categories)
